Definitions & Privileges by Membership Category



Equity (Single or Family)

- Voting privileges
- Subject to assessments
- (1) Person (single) owns equity membership solely or (2) persons living at the same address (spouse/domestic partner) own equity membership jointly.
- Children under the age of 22 living in the same household are entitled to club privileges
- Full golf & tennis privileges
- Food & beverage minimum required
- Full use of practice facility and driving range
- Participation in all club sponsored golf tournaments
- Reciprocal playing privileges with other clubs
- Full club house privileges including all social events
- Memberships are "assignable" as per bylaws
- 5-day advance tee times
- May purchase trail fee or cart lease

Annual (Single or Family)

- Nonvoting membership
- Not subject to assessments
- (1) Person (single) owns membership solely or (2) persons living at the same address (spouse/domestic partner) own membership jointly.
- Children under the age of 22 living in the same household are entitled to club privileges
- Full golf & tennis privileges
- Food & beverage minimum required
- Full use of practice facility and driving range
- Participation in all club sponsored golf tournaments
- Reciprocal playing privileges with other clubs
- Full club house privileges including all social events
- Memberships are not "assignable"
- 5-day advance tee times
- May purchase trail fee or cart lease
- One year commitment is required
- Membership renews annually on anniversary date unless cancelled 30 days prior
- Last month of dues/cap paid up front, then billed monthly

Assignment

- Non-voting membership
- Not subject to assessments
- Only equity members may assign their memberships according to bod approval for minimum of 6 months
- The equity member is responsible for all dues and assessments
- the "assignee" must pay an administration fee and have a special account with the club for charges
- **not permitted** to play in men and women's club championships, annual member/member, president's cup or men's member/guest

Social

- Non-voting membership
- Golf & practice range privileges are not included
- Guest policy applies
- Full tennis privileges
- Full club house privileges including all social events

Senior

- Non-voting membership
- (1) member must be 80+
- Must be a member of good standings for 10 years
- (2) persons living at the same address (spouse/domestic partner) owns membership jointly
- Guest policy applies
- Full golf & tennis privileges
- Full use of practice facility and driving range
- Full club house privileges including all social events
- Participation in all club sponsored golf tournaments
- May serve on committees

Surviving Spouse

- Non-voting membership
- Not subject to assessments
- Assigned to surviving spouse of an equity member
- Full golf & tennis privileges
- Full use of practice facility and driving range
- Full club house privileges including all social events

Seasonal

- Non-voting membership
- Not subject to assessments
- Non-residents of the state of Florida
- Requires proof by means of current voter's registration or evidence of non-homestead status in Florida
- Individual or family membership
- Full golf & tennis privileges

Twilight

- Non-voting membership
- Not subject to assessments
- Annual membership
- Family owns membership
- Unlimited golf at designated twilight times - 9 holes only
- No reciprocal playing privileges with other clubs
- No food & beverage minimums

Summer (Family or Single)

- Non-voting membership
- Not subject to assessments
- (1) Person (single) owns membership solely or (2) persons living at the same address (spouse/domestic partner) own membership jointly.
- Good from may 14th – October 16th
- Children under the age of 23 in the same household entitled to club privileges
- Full golf & tennis privileges including participation in all club golf events
- Full use of practice facility and driving range
- Full club house privileges including all social events
- No reciprocal playing privileges with other clubs
- No food & beverage minimums

Dress Code & Conduct



Dress Code

Golf Course Dress Code:

Appropriate golf attire is required. Ladies shirts must have a collar, if sleeveless, and must have sleeves, if collarless. Crew collars are permitted. Men's shirts must have a collar. Appropriate mock collars are permitted. Denim, tee shirts, gym shorts, tank tops, tube and halter tops, cut-off shorts, shorts less than mid thigh in length, bathing attire, spandex attire, tennis outfits, and similar attire are not permitted.

Clubhouse Dress Code:

Men's shirts must have a collar (mock collars are permitted). Ladies shirts must have a collar, if sleeveless, and must have sleeves, if collarless (crew collars are permitted). Tee-shirts, gym shorts, tank tops, tube and halter tops, cut-off shorts, shorts less than mid thigh in length, bathing attire, spandex attire, tennis outfits, and similar attire are not permitted.

For dinner in the Main Dining Room, the mode of dress for gentlemen is dressy casual, unless otherwise specified. Ladies will dress in a fashion comparable with the dress required of gentlemen. For breakfast and luncheon in the Main Dining Room, informal, casual sports attire may be worn. Denim is permissible unless prohibited for an event by the GM, or Food and Beverage Manager.

No hats or visors shall be worn in the Clubhouse.

Conduct

Each Member is responsible for the conduct of his or her guests. All Suggestions, complements or complaints should be made in writing to the Board of Directors.

- All Golfers must register in the Pro Shop prior to playing.
 - Guests using the facilities must be registered and sponsored by a Club Member.
 - Guests may be invited to use the Club only twice per month between Nov 1-Apr 30.
 - Guests may be sponsored unlimited times between May 1-Oct 30.
 - Guests should be charged the appropriate guest fees. Fees will be higher for a Guest not accompanied by a Club Member.

- Carts may only be used by signing in at the golf shop. Drivers of carts must be 16 years of age or older and have a valid driver's license.
 - Preserve members may operate privately-owned golf carts on the golf course only after an application by the owner, together with payment of an annual pass has been submitted. Evidence of insurance coverage should be provided to the club on an annual basis
